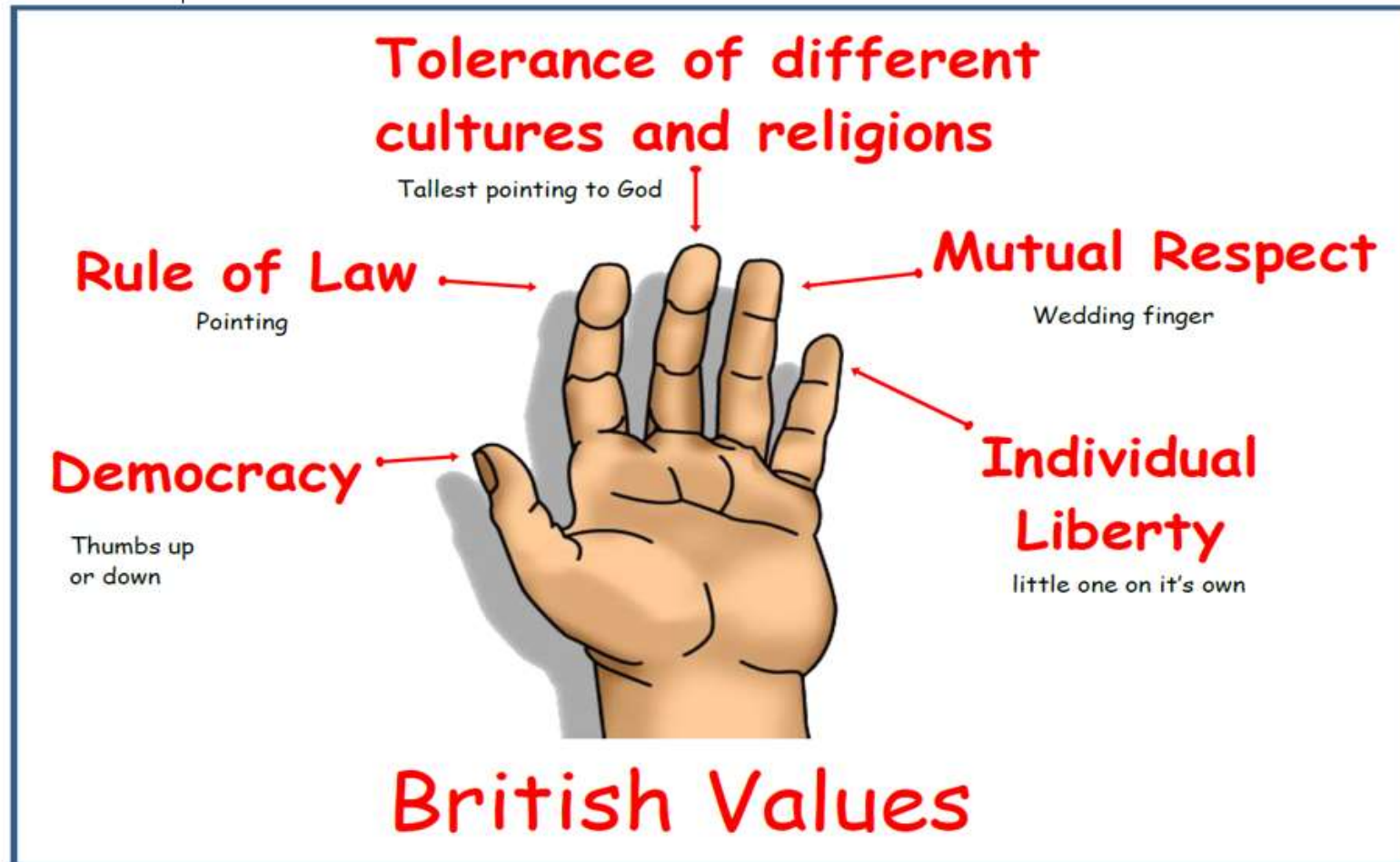


## Promoting British Values

<p><b>Individual Liberty, Mutual Respect, Rule of Law, Democracy, Tolerance</b></p> <p>The District CE Primary School <b>promotes</b> the fundamental British values.
